Buried history

The ancient Roman city of Pompeii, located near Naples, has opened its Central Baths for the first time. Here's what you need to know about these historic structures, as well as the whole archaeological complex

Midnight Cowboy wins Best Picture, making it the only X-rated film to do so in the history of the awards.







Kathryn Bigelow is the first ever female to win the award for Best Director, with The Hurt Locker. She remains the only woman to have won the honour.

Sound engineer Kevin O'Connell wins the award for Best Sound Mixing for Hacksaw Ridge after 20 unsuccessful nominations.

The number of waves that The Wave, a new inland surfing lake in Bristol, United Kingdom, generates per hour. It is the first inland surfing venue in the northern hemisphere to use Wavegarden Cove technology.

The height of the indoor climbing wall at CLYMB Abu Dhabi, which opened in November 2019. This makes it the tallest indoor climbing wall in the world.

The length of the rooftop ski slope at the recently opened CopenHill, a power plant in Copenhagen that doubles as a leisure centre. There's also a CrossFit area and a hiking and running trail.
